At this time we will be adhering to at least the two week closure timeframe recommended by Health and Government officials. We will reassess this as needed and communicate to everyone if we need to remain closed longer or if we are given the go ahead to resume programming and operations sooner.

We recognize the potential impact that closing our center will have to our program participants, their caregivers, and other service providers. Myself, and the management team, will be doing periodic check-ins with program participants and our staff to ensure everyone is still doing ok and continue to feel supported during this time.
